### AN ACT

To amend chapter 304, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to traffic control signal violations.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 304, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 304.282, to read as follows:

3 **304.282. 1. In jurisdictions utilizing automated photo red light enforcement**  
4 **systems, a certified law enforcement officer shall review all video footage of alleged traffic**  
5 **light violations and summons may only be issued by such officer. No summons shall be**  
6 **issued unless the reviewing officer can clearly identify a violation of a traffic control signal**  
7 **and can make a positive identification of the license plate affixed to said vehicle.**

8 **2. For purposes of this section, "automated photo red light enforcement system"**  
9 **means a device consisting of a camera or cameras and vehicle sensor or sensors, installed**  
10 **to work in conjunction with a traffic control signal.**
