AN ACT

To repeal section 285.309, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to employer forms, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 285.309, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu
2 thereof, to be known as section 285.309, to read as follows:

285.309. 1. Every employer doing business in this state who employs five or more
2 employees shall, if applicable, submit federal 1099 miscellaneous forms to the department of
3 revenue **and the department of labor and industrial relations**. Such forms shall be submitted
4 to the department of revenue **and the department of labor and industrial relations** within the
5 time lines established for the filing of Missouri form 99 forms.

6 2. Any employer who intentionally, on five or more occasions, fails to submit
7 information required under subsection 1 of this section shall be fined not more than two hundred
8 dollars for each time the employer fails to submit the information on or after the fifth occurrence.
