

HB 844 -- Civil Air Patrol

Sponsor: Aull

This bill changes the laws regarding members of the civil air patrol who participate in emergency services or counter narcotics missions. In its main provisions, the bill:

- (1) Removes the reference to state employees and makes the provisions applicable to all members of the patrol;
- (2) Changes leave of absence for services to be based on a calendar year instead of a fiscal year; and
- (3) Specifies that no employer is obligated to pay salaries during the period of leave.
