AN ACT

To amend chapter 196, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the labeling of food.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 196, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 196.148, to read as follows:

- 196.148. 1. Any food and food products, including but not limited to livestock or livestock products, poultry or poultry products, or milk or dairy products, sold in this state which contain antibiotics, rBGH, growth hormone treatment, bovine somatotropin, oestradiol, progesterone, testosterone, zeranol, trenbolone, or melengestrol acetate (MGM) shall be labeled indicating that they contain such substances.**
- 2. Any food or food products sold in this state that contain any product or by-product of any genetically manipulated material from a plant or animal treated to change such plant's or animal's DNA from its original composition or has been treated with radiation or pesticides found to be harmful when ingested by humans shall be labeled indicating that they contain such product or by-product.**
