AN ACT

To amend chapter 701, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to lead abatement.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 701, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 701.321, to read as follows:

**701.321. The Missouri department of health and senior services shall not enforce
2 or enact rules or regulations relating to lead abatement that are stricter than those
3 required by federal law. Any such existing rules or regulations that are stricter than those
4 required by federal law shall be null and void.**
