

HB 82 -- Renewable Energy Standard

This bill defines "small modular reactors" as a nuclear reactor with a rated capacity of less than 350 electrical megawatts per reactor that can be constructed and operated in combination with similar reactors at a single site and allows energy produced by these reactors to be used to meet the Renewable Energy Standard percentage requirements for investor-owned electric utilities adopted in Proposition C in 2008.
