

HB 177 -- Automated Speed Enforcement Systems

Sponsor: McNeil

This bill prohibits any county, city, town, village, municipality, state agency, or other political subdivision from using an automated speed enforcement system as specified in the bill to enforce speeding violations within 500 feet of any speed limit sign which reduces the speed limit in the direction of travel. However, such a system may be used in special school zones which are designated with signs. Any evidence obtained in violation of this provision will be inadmissible in any prosecution for speeding.
