

HB 235 -- Sale of Driver Record Information

This bill prohibits the Department of Revenue from selling or disclosing certain driver record information including the information found on a person's driver's license and his or her Social Security number, telephone number, email address, driving record, or any medical or disability information, including restrictions, except as provided by law. The department may release certain information if allowed under the Federal Driver's Privacy Protection Act to a business to verify information voluntarily provided to the business but must charge a fee to cover only the actual costs necessary to process the request for information. The fee cannot be more than that charged for a similar information request under the Open Meetings and Records Law, commonly known as the Sunshine Law.

Any person alleging the unauthorized release of information may bring a claim against the department in a court of proper jurisdiction for civil damages of up to \$10,000, attorney fees, and injunctive relief.
