

HB 365 -- Unlawful Picketing or Protesting of a Funeral

This bill changes the laws regarding unlawful picketing or protesting of a funeral. In its main provisions, the bill:

- (1) Specifies that in order to protect the privacy of grieving families so they can mourn the death of relatives in peace and dignity, it will be unlawful for any person to engage in picketing or other protest activities in front of or about any location at which a funeral is held within one hour prior to the commencement and until one hour following any funeral and within 300 feet of or about any location at which a funeral is held;
- (2) Revises the definition of "funeral" to only be the ceremonies and memorial services held in connection with the burial or cremation of the dead removing processions; and
- (3) Defines "other protest activities" as any action that is disruptive or undertaken to disrupt or disturb a funeral.
