

HB 462 -- MISSOURI ENERGY TASK FORCE

SPONSOR: Pollock

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "do pass by consent" by the Committee on Utilities by a vote of 20 to 0.

This bill repeals the provisions requiring the Missouri Energy Task Force to reconvene at least one time a year and issue a status report to the Governor and General Assembly by December 31 of each year.

FISCAL NOTE: No impact on state funds in FY 2012, FY 2013, and FY 2014.

PROPOSERS: Supporters say that the bill removes unnecessary paperwork. The report is based on outdated information from 2005, and its major recommendations cannot be changed.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Pollock.

OPPOSERS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
