

HB 554 -- Animal Husbandry

This bill defines "animal husbandry" as the branch of agriculture and animal science that is distinct from veterinary medicine and is concerned with the appearance, breeding, care, feeding, housing, hygiene, sanitation, training, and marketing of cows, goats, horses, pigs, poultry, and other farm animals and specifies that acts of animal husbandry for compensation are not prohibited or required to be performed by a veterinarian.
