

HB 1600 -- Retirement Benefits for Members of the General Assembly

This bill changes the retirement eligibility requirements for any person who becomes a member of the General Assembly on or after January 1, 2013, to the attainment of at least age 67 and the completion of at least four full biennial assemblies. Currently, a member is eligible when he or she is at least 62 and has completed three full biennial assemblies.
