

HB 1803 -- Certified School Social Workers

Beginning with the 2012-2013 school year, this bill requires the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, State Board of Education, and Office of Educator Quality to recognize certified school social workers. The State Committee for Social Workers within the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration must issue a certificate to any person making application if the person has obtained a degree in social work from an accredited college or university and holds a valid professional license of social work issued by the state committee and a credential in school social work issued by a nationally recognized credentialing organization in social work as a certified school social worker.
