

HB 1860 -- Agricultural Production Facility Fraud

Sponsor: Guernsey

This bill specifies that a person commits the crime of agricultural production facility fraud if he or she willfully obtains access to an agricultural production facility by false pretenses or knowingly makes a false statement or misrepresentation as part of an application for employment at an agricultural production facility with the intent to commit an act not authorized by the owner.

A person who commits the crime is guilty of a class B misdemeanor and any subsequent violation is a class A misdemeanor. Anyone who aids, abets, acts in concert, or otherwise participates, directly or indirectly, in the commission of the crime is guilty of the crime. Anyone who conspires to commit the crime is subject to the provisions of law regarding conspiracy.
