1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill Nos. 256, 33 & 305, Page 1, Section A, Line 2,  
2 by inserting after all of said section and line, the following:

4 "43.265. There is hereby created in the state treasury the "Highway Patrol's Motor Vehicle,  
5 Aircraft, and Watercraft Revolving Fund", which shall be administered by the superintendent of the  
6 highway patrol. All funds received by the highway patrol from:

7 (1) Any source for purchase of highway patrol motor vehicles, watercraft, watercraft motors,  
8 and trailers;

9 (2) Any source for reimbursement of costs associated with the official use of highway patrol  
10 vehicles;

11 (3) Any source for restitution for damage to or loss of a highway patrol vehicle or aircraft;

12 (4) Any other source for the purchase of highway patrol aircraft or aircraft parts; and

13 (5) Government agencies for the reimbursement of costs associated with aircraft flights  
14 flown on their behalf by the highway patrol;

15 shall be credited to the fund. The state treasurer is the custodian of the fund and shall approve  
16 disbursements from the fund subject to appropriation and as provided by law and the constitution of  
17 this state at the request of the superintendent of the highway patrol. The balances from this fund  
18 shall be used for the purchase of highway patrol motor vehicles, highway patrol watercraft,  
19 watercraft motors, and trailers, highway patrol aircraft or aircraft parts and operational costs. All  
20 expenditures for highway patrol aircraft, aircraft parts and operational costs of any highway patrol  
21 aircraft shall exclusively and solely be used for executing the duties and responsibilities of the  
22 department of public safety and shall not be used for the transportation of any member of the  
23 executive or legislative branch for any other purposes than to execute the functions of the department  
24 of public safety. Any unexpended balance in the fund at the end of the fiscal year shall be exempt  
25 from the provisions of section 33.080 relating to the transfer of unexpended balances to the general  
26 revenue fund."; and

28 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
29 accordingly.
