AN ACT

To amend chapter 578, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to an individual's right to bargain collectively, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 578, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 578.462, to read as follows:

2 **578.462. Any member of the general assembly who proposes a piece of legislation**
3 **that further restricts the right of an individual to bargain collectively, as set forth under**
3 **section 29, article I of the Missouri Constitution, shall be guilty of a class D felony.**
