AN ACT

To repeal section 227.303, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof nine new sections relating to highway designations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 227.303, RSMo, is repealed and nine new sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 227.303, 227.314, 227.325, 227.404, 227.421, 227.515, 227.517, 227.518, and 227.519, to read as follows:

227.303. **1.** The portion of Interstate Highway 70 [within] **from the western city limits of a city not within a county [to the border with the state of Illinois] and proceeding east to mile marker 248** shall be designated the "Mark Twain Highway".

2. The portion of Interstate Highway 70 contained within a city not within a county, from mile marker 248 to the Illinois border, shall be designated the "Andy Gammon Memorial Highway". The department of transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs designating such highway, with the costs for such designation to be paid for by private donations.

227.314. The Missouri portion of the bridge on Interstate 55, Interstate 64, Interstate 70, and U.S. Route 40 crossing the Mississippi River between downtown St. Louis and southwestern Illinois, commonly known as the Poplar Street Bridge, shall be designated the "Congressman William L. Clay, Sr. Bridge". The department of transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs designating the Missouri portion of such bridge, with the costs for such designation to be paid for by private donation. The designation under this section shall supersede any prior name or designation for such bridge.

227.325. The bridge on United States Highway 65 over CST Overlook Avenue in Greene County shall be designated the "Missouri Fallen Soldiers Memorial Bridge". The

3 department of transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs designating such
4 bridge, with the costs for such designation to be paid for by private donations.

227.404. The portion of U.S. Highway 63 in Maries County which is located within the
2 city limits of Vienna shall be designated the "Leona Williams Highway". The department of
3 transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs designating such highway, with the
4 costs to be paid for by private donation.

227.421. The Missouri portion of the new bridge on Interstate 70 crossing the
2 Mississippi River between downtown St. Louis and southwestern Illinois shall be designated
3 the "Stan Musial Memorial Bridge". The department of transportation shall erect and
4 maintain appropriate signs designating the Missouri portion of such bridge, with the costs for
5 such designation to be paid by private donation.

227.515. The portion of Missouri Highway 32 from the city limits of the City of
2 Farmington northeast to the intersection of Missouri Highway 144 shall be designated the
3 "Sergeant Jeffery Kowalski Memorial Highway". The department of transportation shall
4 erect and maintain appropriate signs designating such highway, with the cost to be paid for
5 by private donations.

227.517. The portion of Interstate 70 in St. Louis City from Union Boulevard east to
2 Kingshighway Boulevard shall be designated the "Police Officer Daryl Hall Memorial
3 Highway". The department of transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs
4 designating such highway, with the cost to be paid for by private donations.

227.518. The portion of Interstate Highway 70 beginning at Noland Road and
2 continuing eastward to Lee's Summit Road in Jackson County within the city limits of
3 Independence shall be designated as the "Clifton J. Scott Memorial Highway". The
4 department of transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs designating such
5 highway with the cost for such designation to be paid for by private donation.

227.519. The portion of U.S. Highway 69 in Clay County, beginning from its
2 intersection with Interstate 435, north to its intersection with Interstate 35, shall be designated
3 the "Irvine O. Hockaday, Jr. Highway". The department of transportation shall erect and
4 maintain appropriate signs designating such highway, with the costs to be paid for by private
5 donations.
