1 AMEND House Bill No. 1314, Page 5, Section 1.334, Line 82, by
2 inserting after all of said line the following:

3 "Section 1. 1. For an enrollee who is in the second or
4 third month of a grace period, an issuer of a qualified health
5 plan shall:

6 (1) Upon request by a health care provider or health care
7 facility, provide information regarding the enrollee's
8 eligibility status in realtime; and

9 (2) Notify a health care provider or health care facility
10 that an enrollee is in the grace period within three business
11 days after submittal of a claim or status request for services
12 provided.

13 2. The information or notification required under
14 subsection 1 of this section shall, at a minimum:

15 (1) Indicate "grace period" or use the appropriate national
16 coding standard as the reason for pending the claim if a claim is
17 pending due to the enrollee's grace period status; and

18 (2) Except for notification provided electronically,
19 indicate that the enrollee is in the second or third month of the
20 grace period.

21 3. For purposes of this section, the following terms shall
22 mean:

23 (1) "Grace period", nonpayment of premiums by an enrollee
24 receiving advance payments of the premium tax credit, as defined
25 in Section 1412 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care
26 Act, P.L. 111-148, as amended by the Health Care and Education
27 Reconciliation Act, P.L. 111-152, and implementing regulations
28 issued by the United States Department of Health and Human
29 Services;

2 through an exchange and which has been certified as providing the
3 essential health benefits package required under the Patient
4 Protection and Affordable Care Act, P.L. 111-148, as amended by
