7	"21.860. 1. There is hereby established the "Joint Interim Committee on Health Care
8	Workforce Development" to be composed of twelve members. Six members shall be from the

11	of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives, with two members of the minority party appointed with the advice of the minority leader of the house of representatives. The
12	members of the committee shall elect a chairperson and vice chairperson. Members of the
14	committee shall receive no compensation but may be reimbursed for reasonable and necessary

22	(4) Historical data of the number of students who attended a medical school, nursing school,
23	or other school for health care professionals in Missouri who stayed in the state after achieving a
24	degree and the number of students who left the state;
25	(5) Methods to encourage the retention and recruitment of physicians, nurses, and other
26	health care professionals in and to Missouri; and
27	(6) Any other issues the committee deems relevant to health care workforce development in the state
28 29	<u>the state.</u> <u>3. The committee may hold hearings as it deems advisable and may obtain any input or</u>
30	information necessary to fulfill its obligations. The committee may consult with any state
31	department, public or private university, college, or school, private citizens, or any other person or
32	organization it deems necessary to fulfill its obligations.
33	4. The committee shall submit a report to the general assembly by December 31, 2014,
34	containing the findings of the committee and any recommendations of the committee for attracting
35	and maintaining a strong health care workforce in the state.
