### AN ACT

To amend chapter 253, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to campsite capacity limits.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 253, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 253.565, to read as follows:

**253.565. The allowable and acceptable occupancy on one campsite in a campground  
2 in any Missouri state park shall be as follows:**

3 **(1) A maximum of four sleeping units, only one of which may be wheeled, and one  
4 additional non-sleeping mode of transportation vehicle; and**

5 **(2) A maximum of ten people per campsite, unless the group is indivisible. For  
6 purposes of this section, the term indivisible shall mean a group of persons, campers, tents,  
7 and vehicles that cannot be reasonably divided to occupy more than one campsite such as  
8 parents or guardians with minor children or dependents or a single motorized camper with  
9 its occupants.**
