## AN ACT

To amend chapter 442, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to restrictive covenants.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 442, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 442.404, to read as follows:

- 442.404. 1. Except as otherwise provided by this section, a property owners' 2 association shall not enforce or adopt a restrictive covenant that prohibits a property owner from displaying on the owner's property one or more signs advertising a political candidate or ballot item for an election:
- (1) On or after the ninetieth day before the date of the election to which the sign 5 relates; or 6
  - (2) Before the tenth day after that election date.
- 8 2. This section does not prohibit the enforcement or adoption of a covenant that:
- 9 (1) Requires a sign to be ground-mounted; or
- 10 (2) Limits a property owner to displaying only one sign for each candidate or ballot 11 ite m.
- 12 3. This section does not prohibit the enforcement or adoption of a covenant that 13 prohibits a sign that:
- 14 (1) Contains roofing material, siding, paving materials, flora, one or more balloons or lights, or any other similar building, landscaping, or nonstandard decorative 15 16 component;

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language. HB 1364 2

17 **(2)** Is attached in any way to plant material, a traffic control device, a light, a 18 trailer, a vehicle, or any other existing structure or object;

- (3) Includes the painting of architectural surfaces;
- 20 (4) Threatens the public health or safety;
- 21 (5) Is larger than four feet by four feet;
- 22 (6) Violates a law;

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- 23 (7) Contains language, graphics, or any display that would be offensive to the 24 ordinary person; or
- 25 **(8)** Is accompanied by music or other sounds or by streamers or is otherwise 26 distracting to motorists.
- 4. A property owners' association may remove a sign displayed in violation of a restrictive covenant permitted by this section.

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
