

HB 1427 -- ATTORNEY-CLIENT PRIVILEGE

SPONSOR: McGaugh

This bill specifies that when a trustee retains an attorney for any purpose, the trustee and the attorney communications must be afforded all the protections granted under attorney-client privilege, and no exceptions to the privilege are to be allowed regardless of whether the attorney's services are used for the administration of a trust or otherwise. All other exceptions to the attorney-client privilege recognized by law must remain applicable if warranted by the evidence.
