1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 714, Page 14, Section 190.451, Line 20,
2 by deleting all of said line and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4 "2. (1) Beginning January 1, 2017, or the first day of January after the approval of the ballot
5 measure under subsection 6 of this section, there is hereby imposed a prepaid wireless"; and

7 Further amend said bill and section, Page 15, Line 52, by deleting all of said line and inserting in lieu
8 thereof the following:

10 "(2) Beginning January 1, 2017, or the first day of January after the approval of the ballot
11 measure under subsection 6 of this section, and ending on January 31, 2017, or the thirty first day of
12 January after the approval of the ballot measure under subsection 6 of this section, when a"; and

14 Further amend said bill, section, and page, Line 56, by deleting all of said line and inserting in lieu
15 thereof the following:

17 "from the consumer. Beginning on February 1, 2017, or the first day of February after the
18 approval of the ballot measure under subsection 6 of this section, a seller shall be permitted to
19 deduct"; and

21 Further amend said bill and section, Page 16, Line 111, by inserting the following after all of said
22 line:

24 "6. (1) The prepaid wireless emergency telephone service charge authorized in this section
25 shall not become effective until a ballot measure is submitted and approved by the voters of this
26 state. The ballot measure shall be submitted by the secretary of state for approval or rejection at the
27 general election held and conducted on the Tuesday immediately following the first Monday in
28 November, 2016. If the measure is rejected at such general, the measure may be resubmitted at each
29 subsequent general election until such measure is approved.

30 (2) If a majority of the votes cast on the ballot measure by the qualified voters voting
31 thereon are in favor of such measure, then the prepaid wireless emergency telephone service
32 charge shall be effective on January 1, 2017, or the first day of January after the approval of
33 the ballot measure. If a majority of the votes cast on the ballot measure by the qualified
34 voters voting thereon are opposed to the measure, then the prepaid wireless emergency
35 telephone service charge shall not be imposed unless and until the measure is approved."; and
