AN ACT

To amend chapter 1, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to regulations resulting from presidential executive orders.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 1, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 1.345, to read as follows:

3 **1.345. 1. Any federal regulation, rule, or memorandum promulgated as a result of**
4 **an executive order of the President of the United States is repugnant to the Constitution**
5 **of the United States and the Constitution of Missouri and shall be declared invalid in this**
6 **state. Such regulations, rules, or memorandums shall be considered null and void and of**
7 **no effect, and no agency or political subdivision of this state shall take any action or utilize**
8 **any resources to give effect to such rules, regulations, or memorandums.**

9 **2. It shall be duty of the general assembly to adopt and enact any and all measures**
10 **as may be necessary to prevent the enforcement of regulations, rules, and memorandums**
11 **issued by a presidential executive order.**
