

HCS HB 499 -- PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE IN SCHOOLS (Roden)

COMMITTEE OF ORIGIN: Standing Committee on Emerging Issues in Education

Currently, every school that is supported in whole or in part by public moneys must ensure that the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of the United States of America is recited in at least one scheduled class of every student enrolled in that school at least once per week. This bill requires the pledge to be recited in the English language at least once per school day. Any person is authorized to voluntarily donate flags of the United States of America for display in individual classrooms.
