

HB 889 -- ELECTIONS

SPONSOR: Curtman

This bill requires the use of paper ballots as the official ballots for all elections. Disabled voters may make use of ballot marking devices allowing them to vote a paper ballot. Existing touch screen electronic voting machines used by disabled voters may continue to be used until they expire from mechanical failure or are removed from service for any reason, but they may not be replaced.

An election may not be certified until an audit of the election returns has been completed.
