

HB 939 -- TICKET PURCHASER PROTECTIONS

SPONSOR: McCreery

This bill prohibits an individual, corporation, business, or company from:

(1) Restricting the resale of any ticket or season ticket package as a condition of sale, to retain the ticket or ticket package for the duration of the subscription or season ticket package agreement, or to retain any contractually agreed upon rights to purchase or transfer future ticket subscriptions or season ticket packages;

(2) Denying access to a ticket holder solely on the basis that the ticket was resold; and

(3) Employing a paperless ticketing system, unless the consumer is given the option to purchase a paperless ticket which is transferable.

The bill does not prohibit an individual, corporation, business, or company from:

(1) Maintaining or enforcing its policies with regard to conduct or behavior in connection with its venue; and

(2) Restricting the resale of tickets which are sold as part of a targeted promotion or are donated for charitable or civic purposes.
