

HB 1063 -- STATE CAPITOL COMPLEX COMMITTEE

This bill creates the State Capitol Complex Committee which will consist of the Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the President Pro Tem of the Senate, or their respective designated representatives. The committee has general supervision and charge of the state capitol building, state capitol parking garages, and any other state-owned or leased buildings adjacent to or in the immediate vicinity of the state capitol building that house any offices of the General Assembly or its staff. The committee must meet at least annually and may hold special meetings when at least two of the committee members request it. Majority approval of the members of the committee is necessary to decide any action regarding the buildings or property under the purview of the committee.
