

HB 1071 -- EXECUTIVE ORDERS

SPONSOR: Remole

This bill specifies that any federal regulation, rule or memorandum promulgated as a result of an executive order of the President of the United States cannot constitutionally be used to modify, change, or extend a federal law or regulation and any presidential executive order is null and void. An agency or political subdivision of Missouri may not take action or use resources to enact the laws, orders, or memorandums. It is the duty of the General Assembly to enact legislation preventing the use of state resources to enforce the federal rule, regulation, or memorandum issued by a presidential executive order.
