1 AMEND House Bill No. 1550, Page 4, Section 452.375, Lines 110-112, by deleting all of said lines
2 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4 "10. After August 28, 2016, every court order establishing or modifying custody or visitation shall
5 include the following language: "In the event of noncompliance with this order, the aggrieved party
6 may file a verified motion for contempt. If custody, visitation or third-party custody is denied or
7 interfered with by a parent or third party without good cause, the aggrieved person may file a family
8 access motion with the court stating the specific facts which constitute a violation of the custody
9 provisions of the judgment of dissolution, legal separation or judgment of paternity. The circuit
10 clerk will provide the aggrieved party with an explanation of the procedures for filing a family
11 access motion and a simple form for use in filing the family access motion. A family access motion
12 does not require the assistance of legal counsel to prepare and file."; and

14 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
15 accordingly.
