AN ACT

To repeal section 660.025, RSMo, relating to grants to programs engaged in resettling refugees.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 660.025, RSMo, is repealed, to read as follows:

2 [660.025. Subject to appropriation from general revenue, the director of
3 social services shall offer grants, on a competitive basis, to programs which are
4 engaged in the resettling of refugees and legal immigrants for the purpose of
5 arranging for day care, transportation or other services that will facilitate a
6 refugee's or immigrant's accessing of English language services. The department
7 of social services may promulgate rules to govern the grant program, pursuant to
8 the provisions of chapter 536. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is
9 defined in section 536.010, that is promulgated by the department of social
10 services under the authority of this section, shall become effective only if the
11 department has fully complied with all of the requirements of chapter 536
12 including but not limited to, section 536.028, if applicable, after August 28, 1998.
13 All rulemaking authority delegated prior to August 28, 1998, is of no force and
14 effect and repealed as of August 28, 1998, however nothing in this act shall be
15 interpreted to repeal or affect the validity of any rule adopted and promulgated
16 prior to August 28, 1998. If the provisions of section 536.028 apply, the
17 provisions of this section are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with
18 the general assembly pursuant to section 536.028 to review, to delay the effective
19 date, or to disapprove and annul a rule or portion of a rule are held
20 unconstitutional or invalid, the purported grant of rulemaking authority and any
21 rule so proposed and contained in the order of rulemaking shall be invalid and
22 void, except that nothing in this act shall affect the validity of any rule adopted
and promulgated prior to August 28, 1998.]

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EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
