FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Oversight notes this proposal clarifies that a board of education shall act only during legally called board meetings. Additionally, it clarifies how vacancies that occur on a school board should be filled. Oversight assumes these changes would not have a fiscal impact.

Officials at the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the **Concordia R-II, Everton, Kansas City, Kearney R-I, Macon County R-IV, Malta Bend, Pettis County R-XII, Salisbury, Seymour R-II, Special School District of St. Louis, St. Elizabeth, West Plains** and the **Wright City R-II** school districts each assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal to their respective districts.

The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
