State Fiscal Highlights

Fiscal Analysis

Oversight assumes this legislation modifies the membership for the 911 board for Taney County and will not have a direct fiscal impact on either the state or Taney County.

<u>House Amendment 1</u> - **Oversight** assumes House Amendment 1 could possibly add additional counties within Section 190.103 and should have no direct fiscal impact to the proposal.

<u>House Amendment 2</u> - **Oversight** assumes this proposal reflects a change codifying statute and should have no direct fiscal impact to the proposal.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
