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**Bill Summary:** This proposal modifies the membership for the 911 board for Taney County and changes the laws regarding the powers and duties of Regional EMS Medical Directors.

State Fiscal Highlights

Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.


Fiscal Analysis

**Oversight** assumes this legislation modifies the membership for the 911 board for Taney County and will not have a direct fiscal impact on either the state or Taney County.

House Amendment 1 - **Oversight** assumes House Amendment 1 could possibly add additional counties within Section 190.103 and should have no direct fiscal impact to the proposal.

House Amendment 2 - **Oversight** assumes this proposal reflects a change codifying statute and should have no direct fiscal impact to the proposal.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
