AN ACT

To amend chapter 190, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the use of restraints in overdose treatment.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 190, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 190.257, to read as follows:

190.257. 1. For the purposes of this section, the term “first responder” shall have the same meaning ascribed to it as in section 190.100.

2. Any first responder who in good faith provides emergency care or treatment to a person suffering from an apparent drug or alcohol overdose by the use or provision of restraints shall not be held liable for any civil damages as a result of such care or treatment unless the first responder acts in a willful and wanton or reckless manner in the use or provision of such restraints.
