AN ACT

To repeal sections 57.450 and 57.452, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to law enforcement officers in the city of St. Louis.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 57.450 and 57.452, RSMo, are repealed and two new sections 2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 57.450 and 57.452, to read as follows:

57.450. All general laws relating and applicable to the sheriffs of the several counties
of this state shall apply to the same officer in the city of St. Louis[, except that]. Beginning
January 1, 2025, the sheriff of the city of St. Louis shall [not] enforce the general criminal laws
of the state of Missouri [unless such enforcement shall be incidental to the duties customarily
performed by the sheriff of the city of St. Louis]. All acts and parts of acts providing for any
legal process to be directed to any sheriff of any county shall be so construed as to mean the
sheriff of the city of St. Louis as if such officer were specifically named in such act.
57.452. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the provisions of [section]

2 590.180] chapter 590 that apply to a law enforcement officer employed by a municipal
3 police department in a city not within a county shall [not] apply to any elected or appointed
4 sheriff of a city not within a county and to any law enforcement officer employed by any
5 sheriff of a city not within a county.
