

HB 1496 -- SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

SPONSOR: Walton Gray

This bill specifies that the juvenile court shall consider ordering a juvenile to attend school in lieu of being detained or fined for a misdemeanor violation, violating an ordinance, or as a condition of probation. If the juvenile obtains two unexcused absences, the juvenile may then be detained or fined, as determined by the juvenile court.

This bill is the same as HB 61 (2015).
