

HB 2051 -- RESIDENCE ADDRESS FOR DRIVERS LICENSE

SPONSOR: Moon

This bill allows certain individuals who are or were parole officers, law enforcement officers, judicial employees or a member of their immediate family to use an alternative address on his or her driver's license. The alternative address is the street address of the courthouse in the county of the person's residence. The applicant must provide to the Department of Revenue proof that the applicant is qualified for a residence address exemption and provide an actual residence address for department records and mailing purposes. The person must notify the department no later than 30 days after the license holder ceases to qualify for an exemption and must apply for a duplicate license that displays the person's actual current residence address.
