

SB 1002 -- Community Improvement District Audits

SPONSOR: Hegeman (Pfautsch)

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Government Oversight and Accountability by a vote of 6 to 0.

This bill allows the office of the State Auditor to conduct audits of community improvement districts in a manner similar to state agency audits. Costs of the audit are paid for by the Auditor's Office and not the community improvement district.

PROPOSERS: Supporters say that the bill allows the Office of the State Auditor authority to initiate an audit of certain community improvement districts that do not have residential members and, therefore, are currently not able to be audited via the petition process.

Testifying for the bill were Senator Hegeman and the Office Of The State Auditor.

OPPOSERS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
