AN ACT

To amend chapter 215, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the prevailing wage on low-income housing, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 215, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 215.042, to read as follows:

215.042. 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, for any housing eligible for a housing tax credit, the commission shall not require a prevailing hourly wage to be paid to any contractor for any work performed on such housing.

- 2. Any contractor engaged in the construction of any housing eligible for a housing tax credit in violation of section 285.530 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor offense and punished for each violation thereof by a fine not to exceed five thousand dollars, or by imprisonment not exceeding fifteen days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
- 3. Any contractor engaged in the construction of any housing eligible for a housing tax credit in violation of section 285.530 shall not be eligible for any state funding or tax credits issued by the state for a period of five years following such violation.
