**AN ACT**

To amend chapter 192, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the inspection of certain x-ray systems.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 192, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new  
2 section, to be known as section 192.500, to read as follows:

**192.500. 1. For purposes of this section, the following terms shall  
2 mean:**

3       **(1) "Cone beam computed tomography system", a medical imaging  
4 device using x-ray computed tomography to capture data using a cone-  
5 shaped x-ray beam, which has radiation intensity no greater than thirty  
6 milligrays;**

7       **(2) "Panoramic x-ray system", an imaging device that captures  
8 the entire mouth in a single, two-dimensional image including the  
9 teeth, upper and lower jaws, and surrounding structures and tissues.**

10       **2. Cone beam computed tomography systems and panoramic x-  
11 ray systems shall not be required to be inspected more frequently than  
12 every four years.**

13       **3. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, inspections of x-ray  
14 equipment used exclusively on animals by a licensed veterinarian or  
15 veterinary facility under chapter 340 shall not be required to be  
16 inspected more frequently than every four years.**

17       **4. The provisions of this section shall expire on December 31,  
18 2025.**
