AN ACT

To amend chapter 536, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to revenue producing regulations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 536, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 536.185, to read as follows:

536.185. 1. For the purposes of this section, the following terms shall mean:

2 **(1) “Committee”, the committee on administrative rules established in section**
3 **536.037;**

4 **(2) “Revenue producing”, regulations that require fees, surcharges, or expense**
5 **reimbursement to government officials for their regulatory activities;**

6 **(3) “Sunset”, the termination of legislative authorization of a program.**

7 **2. Each state agency shall conduct a review all of its regulations before November**
8 **1, 2017, and shall submit those regulations that have a reasonable chance of being**
9 **considered revenue producing to the committee for review.**

10 **3. Upon determination that a regulation will be revenue producing the committee**
11 **shall ensure the regulation has a sunset provision if it does not already.**

12 **4. If an agency would like to continue a regulation that is revenue producing it shall**
13 **submit to the general assembly notice of such regulation. Within sixty days of notice, the**
14 **general assembly shall consider a joint resolution to approve the continuance of the**
15 **regulation. If approved, the joint resolution shall be sent to the governor for his or her**
16 **signature.**

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

17 **5. The committee, on occasion, may audit the agencies to ensure they are in**
18 **compliance with this section.**
