AN ACT

To amend chapter 84, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the Kansas City police department.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 84, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 84.514, to read as follows:

84.514. The chief of police, with the approval of the board, may appoint a police
2 **officer to serve as lieutenant colonel on matters relating to homeland security.**
3 **Notwithstanding the provisions of section 84.510 to the contrary, such position shall be a**
4 **new position and in addition to the number of lieutenant colonels authorized under section**
5 **84.510. The lieutenant colonel authorized under this section shall be responsible for**
6 **matters relating to homeland security as determined by the chief and be entitled to the**
7 **same rank, privileges, and compensation afforded all other lieutenant colonels within the**
8 **department.**
