2 3 4	WHEREAS, in 1912 the Children's Bureau was created and has worked to assist children and youth in foster care; engage youth in decisions that affect their lives; and support foster families, kinship caregivers, child welfare professionals, and others who keep these children; and

6 7 8	WHEREAS, in 1988 President Reagan issued the first presidential proclamation that established the month of May as National Foster Care Month; and
9 10 11 12 13	WHEREAS, a yearly proclamation from the President supports the Children's Bureau in their effort by recognizing the work of foster families, social workers, faith-based and community organizations, and others who are improving the lives of young people in foster care across the country and by encouraging all Americans to participate in efforts to serve these children throughout the year; and

15 16	WHEREAS , in 2012, 1,172 children were adopted from foster care in Missouri while another 2,067 children in Missouri foster care were waiting to be adopted; and

18 19	WHEREAS, research shows that youth who age out of foster care will face obstacles such as homelessness, unemployment, early parenting, and substance abuse; and

21 22	WHEREAS, adoption provides children with a lifetime of emotional and lega connections to a family; and

24 WHEREAS, if foster parents and relative caregivers are provided with adequate support, 25 they will be in a better position to provide children with permanency: 26 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the House of 27 28 Representatives of the Ninety-ninth General Assembly, First Regular Session, the Senate concurring therein, hereby designate the month of May as Foster Care Awareness Month in the 29 30 state of Missouri; and 31 32 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the General Assembly recommends to the citizens 33 of this state to observe the month by taking time to help youth in foster care and recognizing the commitment of all who touch their lives. 34
