#### AN ACT

To amend chapter 167, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to home school students.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 167, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 167.197, to read as follows:

167.197. 1. For purposes of this section, the following terms mean:

4 (1) "Eligible student", a student who is receiving instruction through a home 5 school, as defined in section 167.031;

6 (2) "School of residence", the public school in whose attendance area an eligible 7 student resides.

8 2. The school of residence of an eligible student shall provide the eligible student 9 with the opportunity to participate in any extracurricular activity offered by such school 10 in the same manner it provides the opportunity to enrolled students.

3. An eligible student who seeks to participate or who participates in an activity on behalf of a public school is subject to the relevant policies that apply to students enrolled in the public school including, but not limited to, policies regarding registration, age eligibility, fees, insurance, transportation, physical condition, qualifications, responsibilities, event schedules, standards of behavior, and performance, in addition to the home instruction academic and attendance requirements as described in section 167.031.
