	WHEREAS, effective November 1, 2016, the Missouri Conservation Commission
2	selected Sara Parker Pauley as Director of the Department of Conservation; and
3	
4	WHEREAS, from December 2010, until such date, Pauley served as the Director of the
5	Missouri Department of Natural Resources; and
6 7	WHEREAS, in 2008, the state of Missouri received over \$30 million from a legal
8	settlement with the American Smelting and Refining Company (ASARCO) to remediate
9	environmental damages in Southeast Missouri's lead mining district; and
10	en in onitional authages in Southeast Prissouri s read mining district, and
11	WHEREAS, the settlement agreement limited that the settlement funds could only be
12	spent on restoration activities at or in connection with five specific sites; and
13	
14	WHEREAS, instead of spending the funds on vital environmental remediation in the
15	affected areas, the Department of Natural Resources, under the command of Pauley, spent more
16	than \$20 million of the settlement funds on the acquisition of land in Oregon County; and
17	
18	WHEREAS, the Oregon County property is nowhere near the area where most of the
19	environmental damage occurred and is not even in the same watershed; and
20	
21	WHEREAS, the department claims that the land will be used to develop a new state park
22	in Oregon County; and
23	
24	WHEREAS, the use of the settlement funds was clearly unauthorized and unjustified;

27	WHEREAS, because of her involvement in such a blatant misuse of state funds, Pauley
28	should not be entrusted with leading one our most important state agencies:
