## TAX RELIEF FOR MISSOURI SENIORS AND DISABLED

**The Missouri Property Tax Credit** allows a credit to certain senior citizens and 100% disabled individuals based on total household income (taxable and nontaxable) and the amount of property taxes or rent paid. The credit is for a maximum of \$750 for renters and \$1,100 for those who own and occupy a home.

***To be eligible a person must be:***

- 65 years of age or older,
- 60 years of age or older and receiving Social Security surviving spouse benefits, or
- 100% disabled

***The maximum income level to qualify is:***

**OWNED AND OCCUPIED HOME FOR ENTIRE YEAR**

**Single** - \$30,000

**Married filing jointly** - \$34,000

**RENTERS/PART YEAR OWNERS**

**Single** - \$27,500

**Married filing jointly** - \$29,500

# MoRx Plan Helps Pay for Prescription Drugs

MoRx pays for 50% of members' out of pocket costs remaining after their Medicare Prescription Drug Plan pays. It pays 50% of the deductible, 50% of co-pays before the coverage gap, 50% of the coverage gap, and 50% in catastrophic coverage co-pays. MoRx does not pay the Medicare Part D Plan's monthly premium.

Any drug covered by a member's Medicare Drug Plan also will be covered by the MoRx plan.

Dual eligible members will continue to have coverage for Medicare-excluded drugs through MOHealthNet. Medicare-excluded drugs include specific over-the-counter drugs, vitamins, minerals, limited cough and cold drugs, benzodiazepines, and barbiturates as they are currently covered by MO HealthNet, as noted on the MO HealthNet Division Pharmacy pages.
