

The following is a list of all of the bills Truly Agreed to and Finally Passed by the General Assembly this session.

- 1-19 Appropriates state governmental funds
- 41 Removes portions of the **school funding formula** that are no longer relevant due to the passage of time
- 42 Changes the laws regarding **elementary and secondary education**
- 50 Changes the laws regarding the business of **insurance**
- 63 Changes the laws regarding **persons seeking public office**
- 88 Designates July 3 of each year as "**Organ Donor Recognition Day**"
- 92 Changes the laws regarding the **Department of Natural Resources**
- 111 Changes the laws regarding **sales tax on used manufactured homes**
- 116 **Prohibits** an employer from **requiring a person to become a member of a labor organization** as a condition or continuation of employment
- 125 Specifies that the **directors of any industrial development corporation formed by a municipality in St. Francois County** may be taxpayers and registered voters in the county
- 137 Changes the laws regarding **competitive bidding for a contract license office**
- 150 Modifies the duration of **unemployment compensation**, the method to pay federal advances, and raises the fund trigger causing contribution rate reductions
- 179 Allows a retired military member to provide a Veterans' Identification Card issued by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs in order to receive a **veteran designation on his or her driver's license**
- 259 Establishes the **Missouri Dairy Revitalization Act of 2015**
- 269 Requires **motorboats** to carry two B1 type **fire extinguishers**, one B2 fire extinguisher, or a fixed fire extinguisher and one B1 type fire extinguisher
- 326 Specifies that each **defined benefit pension plan** must establish a **board member education program**
- 343 Establishes a **committee to assess the continuation of the Money Follows the Person Demonstration Program** in order to help disabled or aging individuals transition from nursing facilities to community settings
- 361 Designates the third week of February as "**Engineer Awareness Week**" in Missouri
- 384 Changes the laws regarding **taxation**
- 385 Defines "**correspondence**" with regard to **real estate brokers**
- 391 Changes the **notice requirements for automobile insurance cancellations** or refusals
- 400 Designates the month of November each year as "**Epilepsy Awareness Month**"
- 402 Designates the first full week before Memorial Day as "**Safe Boating Week**"
- 403 Designates Missouri as a **Purple Heart State**


