67.309	SB 1048	Burlison	Under this bill, no political subdivision shall adopt an ordinance, resolution, regulation, code or policy that prohibits, or has the effect of prohibiting, the connection or reconnection of a utility service based upon the type or source of energy to be delivered to an individual customer.
44.080, Section B	Amendment	O'Donnell	A state of emergency declared by a county shall not continue for more than 15 days without a 60% vote of the county governing body. A political subdivision shall not adopt an ordinance that prohibits the connection of utility service based upon the type or source of energy to be delivered.
192.300	Amendment	Dorhman	A country health board shall only act in an advisory capacity to a county commission.
321.621	SB 617 (perfected version)	Cunningham	DHSS must provide epi-pens for adult patients to fire protection districts in nonmetropolitan areas of Missouri. Possession and use of epi-pens is limited to qualified first responders who have completed a training course. Every use of an epi-pen shall be reported to a emergency health care provider. The use of an epi-pen is considered first aid or emergency treatment for purposes of liability under the law and shall not constitute the unlawful practice of medicine. Any person that violates the provisions of this act shall be guilty of a Class B misdemeanor. This bill establishes the "Epinephrine Auto-injector Devices for Fire Personnel Fund".

163.024	3762H05.05H (HB 1817 perfected version)	Dinkins	HB 1817 - Excludes certain administrative penalties from the calculation of local effort in Iron County
163.011	3762H05.06H (HB 1818)	Dinkins	HB 1818 - Removes increases in the amount received from fines for school purposes from the calculation of local effort for school districts

29.230	3762H05.07H (SB 615)	Cunningham	SB 615 - Modifies provisions relating to audits of county offices
