State Rep. Dirk Deaton Named Chair of House Budget Committee

JEFFERSON CITY, Mo. – Missouri House Speaker Jon Patterson today announced the selection of State Representative Dirk Deaton, R-Noel, to serve as the chairman of the House Budget Committee for the 103rd General Assembly. Deaton, who for the last four years has served as the vice chairman of the powerful committee, will lead the House as it works to craft a multi-billion-dollar state operating budget during the 2025 legislative session.

Deaton comes into the role after the Missouri General Assembly approved a state operating budget of approximately \$50 billion for Fiscal Year 2025 in the previous legislative session. As chairman of the Budget Committee, Deaton will oversee the appropriations process in the House. He will have the responsibility of filing all appropriations bills and working with his various appropriations committee chairs to craft a fiscally responsible spending plan. Once the budget bills have received House approval and moved to the Missouri Senate, Deaton will serve as the lead negotiator to maintain the budget priorities of House members.

"I want to thank Speaker Patterson for entrusting me with the responsibility of leading our budget process. I firmly believe that our goal in crafting a fiscally responsible budget should always be serving as a good steward of taxpayer dollars while protecting the interests of Missouri taxpayers. I

look forward to beginning the work with my colleagues in the House to guide our passing a responsible and balanced budget," Deaton said.

Representative Deaton represents McDonald and Newton counties (District 159) in the Missouri House of Representatives.
